

## Course in International Mobilization for the Inalienable Rights of Palestinian People

### A Human Rights Based Approach to Palestinian People Rights

BADIL Resource Center for Palestinian Residency and Refugees Rights will hold its inaugural *Course in International Mobilization for the Inalienable Rights of Palestinian People* from **Wednesday, July 31 to Friday, August 9, 2019 in Bethlehem, Palestine.**

BADIL is an independent, human rights non-profit organization committed to protecting and promoting the rights of Palestinian refugees and internally displaced persons. Our vision, mission, programs and relationships are defined by our Palestinian identity and the principles of international humanitarian and human rights law. We seek to advance the individual and collective rights of the Palestinian people on this basis.

**Who:** BADIL is inviting international advocates, activists, mobilizers, and policy officers from across the spectrum to apply.

**What:** This course aims to provide participants with a deeper understanding of the Palestinian case through in depth lectures, discussions, and field visits in connection with the facts on the ground. Discussions and lectures will traverse, among other issues, both current and historical, Palestinian peoples' denial of access to and realization of their rights. Lectures will be underpinned by field visits on both sides of the Green Line and will allow participants to witness first-hand the reality and mechanisms of Israeli policies of forcible displacement, annexation, and apartheid from Palestinians enduring such violations.

**Outcome:** The program will provide the space for working discussions on tangible strategies to improve international solidarity for Palestinian people. These will include discerning proactive approaches to advancing Palestinian people's rights within the international solidarity, mobilization, and advocacy communities, ways to elevate Palestinian voices on the international stage, and will use a human-rights based approach needed to connect and unify the international discourse and actions surrounding the Palestinian struggle. Participants will leave with enhanced abilities to defend, promote, and advance Palestinian rights within the international community accompanied by a strengthened mobilization network of international organizations and individuals.

Participation in the course includes accommodation, meals, and travel within Palestine. A fee of **\$200** is required upon **registration**. Participants will be responsible for the cost of their international travel.
