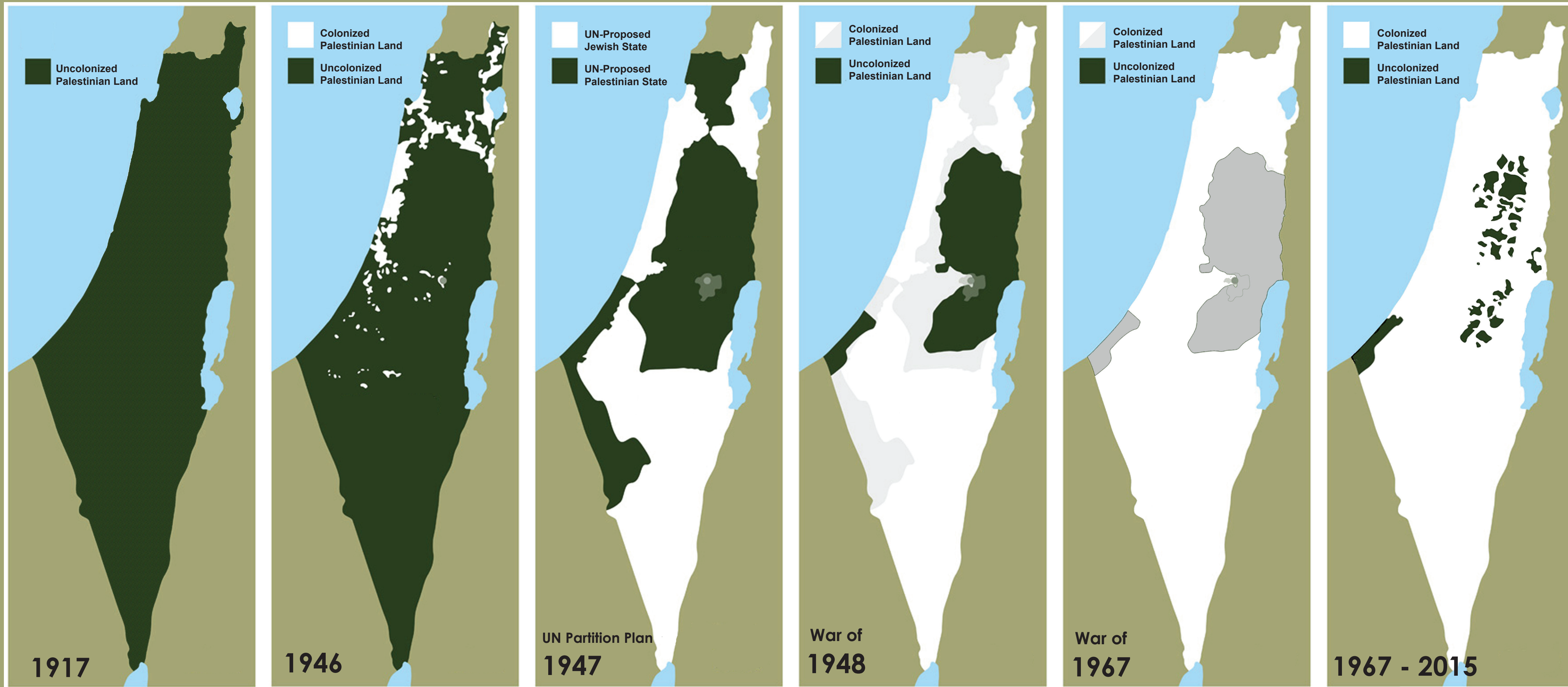
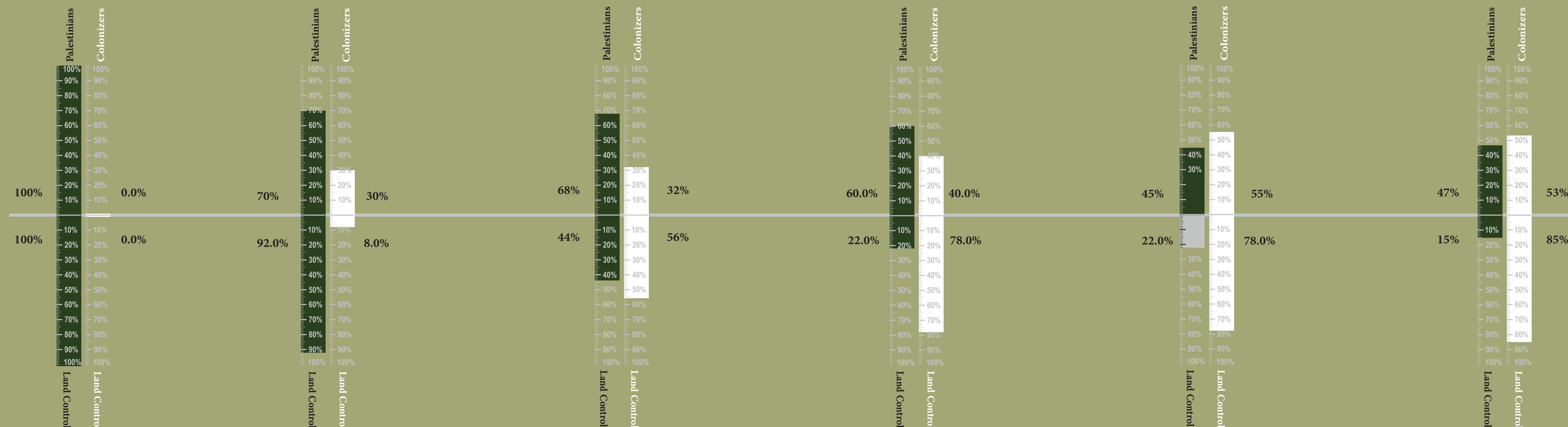


# “Maximum Land with Minimum Palestinians” The Ongoing NAKBA since 1917

## THE MECHANISMS OF DISPLACEMENT COLONIZATION, APARTHEID AND OCCUPATION



By the end of **2014**, at least **67%** (7.9 million) of the entire, worldwide Palestinian population (11.8 million) were forcibly displaced persons. Among them were at least **7.25 million** Palestinian refugees and **718,800** internally displaced persons (IDPs).



- 1948 Palestinian refugees, 6.14 million (77% of all displaced Palestinians):
  - UNRWA-registered refugees 5.1 million (64%)
  - Refugees not registered with UNRWA 1.05 million (13.1%)
- 1967 Palestinian refugees 1,113,200 (13.9%)
- IDPs in Israel since 1948 384,200 (4.8%)
- IDPs in the OPT since 1967 334,600 (4.2%)

Most Palestinian refugees (approximately 81%) live outside UNRWA's 58 camps. The majority of the refugees still live within 100 km from their homes of origin.
